

Mission

To undo the historic and continuing injustice and inequality created through redlining and discriminatory housing policies by federal, state and local governments, banks and realtors that people of color, Black communities in particular, experience when attempting to purchase a home of their own. The Touhey Foundation acknowledges that Black homebuyers face increased barriers to homeownership that directly stem from discriminatory policies and seeks to provide funding for buyers to overcome these barriers.

Program

The Reparative Housing Justice Fund offers grants of up to \$10,000 to assist Black homebuyers in purchasing a home in the Capital Region. RHJF grants may be used to address a variety of financial barriers to homeownership, including down payment costs, closing cost, personal credit issues and other associated home purchase costs.

Eligibility

RHJF grants must be used for direct or indirect costs associated with purchasing a home in the Capital Region. Funds are intended for homebuyers who identify as Black/African American.

Approved applicants will receive further instruction on award disbursements and reporting requirements.

Application Process:

Applicants should submit the following items to: <u>info@buildingblockstoegther.com</u> to be considered for the Restorative Housing Justice Fund Grant:

- Completed application
- Proof of application processing fee
- Executed Contract of Sale
- Photo ID
- Mortgage Application (URLA)

<u>Approved applicants</u> will receive a conditional award letter with further instructions on funding disbursements and reporting. To receive funds, applicants will be asked to submit:

- Loan Estimate
- Mortgage Commitment Letter
- Final Closing Disclosure
- Outcomes Report

<u>Denied/Waitlisted Applicants</u> will receive a notice of declination. Applicants who are waitlisted due to funding constraints, are strongly encouraged to continue in their homebuying and seek out other funding sources. Once funding becomes available, Building Blocks Together staff will contact waitlisted applicants in the order of submission.



Please allow for 3-5 business days for application processing.

Disbursement of Funds:

Closing Notification

Building Blocks Together staff should be notified 3 to 5 business days **before the closing** of the Check Payee

Document Submission:

For the funds to be disbursed in a timely manner, all required documents must be received no later than **72** hours before the scheduled closing

Grant Check Pick-up:

Grant checks will be available for pick-up at a predetermined location.

Monday: 10:00 AM to 12:00PM Wednesday: 9:30 AM to 1:00 PM

Grant Application Processing Fee:

- All submitted applications will be subject to a \$50 processing fee (non-refundable)

First Time Homebuyer Requirement: None, however strongly encouraged

Other Items:

- Any action that results in the client not moving forward with the property outlined in the RHJF application will result in your application being void
- There will be NO:
 - Lien placed against the property
 - Expectation of repayment of the grant despite the number of years the buyer remains in the property
- There are **NO** Area Median Income (AMI) requirements
